

## Recycling Guide

SINGLE STREAM "Recycling Made Simple"

For your convenience, we offer Single Stream Recycling. Simply label your designated recycling barrels, "recycling" and place all of your recyclables within the same container. You no longer have to separate your recyclables into small, inconvenient bins! Note: barrels should be standard sized, 30-64 gallon barrels and should not be placed directly next to your trash barrels. Your recycling will be picked up in a separate truck. Please have your recyclables ready and accessible by 8:00 AM on your collection day.

## What you CAN Recycle

It ALL goes in together

Newspapers, Magazines, Catalogs

Telephone/Soft Cover Books

Junk Mail/Envelopes (all types)

Paper (all colors, staples/paperclips are okay)

Paperboard (cereal/shoe boxes)

Milk/Juice Cartons

Cardboard/Brown Paper Bags

Plastic food & beverage containers marked #1-7

Soda/Juice/Water Bottles (glass or plastic)

Milk Jugs, Bleach/Detergent, Shampoo Bottles

Food Containers (cottage cheese/margarine/

yogurt)

Glass Bottles/Jars (any color)

Aluminum (pie plates/trays/foil)

Metal Cans (tin/steel/aluminum)

Note: All food/beverage containers should be washed and rinsed prior to collection

## What NOT to Recyle

No Plastic Bags (or recyclables in Plastic Bags)

No Unmarked Plastics:

laundry baskets/chairs/toys

No Windows/Light Bulbs

No Dishes, No Pyrex, No Ceramics

No Foam Packaging, No Styrofoam

No Aerosol Cans (paint/hairspray/cleaners)

No Mirrors

No Recyclables Containing Food Waste
